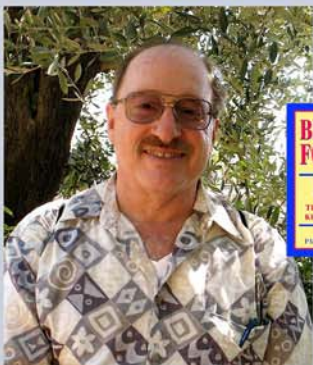


Bring family and friends for a night of science, discovery, fun, appetizers, and a take-home surprise!
